1. Hint - makes a brown or white treat:

COCOA - the pods contain beans that are used to make chocolate



2. Hint - the world's most popular fruit:

BANANA - a plant (not tree) with large leaves to absorb sunlight. We have Canary and Wild Bananas in the Tropical House



3. Hint - makes ice cream so tasty:

VANILLA - an orchid, where the seeds provide the taste and smell. It climbs to get closer to the light (epiphyte).



4. Hint - a black and white spice:

PEPPER - the world's most traded spice. Both black and white pepper come from the same plant.
