- 3. To ensure all BBG assets such as tools & plants are well looked after and maintained, that all BBG facilities are respected and kept tidy e.g., break areas, toilets.

4. To work independently and part as a team, towards the area management plan and in line with Living Collections Strategy, Health and Safety policy.

SUPERVISION

Working under the direction and/or supervision of Botanical Horticulturists and other more senior staff.

Manual handling, hot, humid, cold, small spaces, public areas and back of house areas.
