INTRODUCTION

Birmingham Botanical Gardens is an independent educational charity aiming to offer world class environmental education in a green environment to audiences in all sectors of the community.

ROLE PURPOSE

To assist in the essential weekend horticultural duties, under the supervision of the duty horticulturist. To support ensuring the glasshouses are adequately watered and floors bumped ready for opening times, litter picking and any other essential horticultural tasks for the weekend. To start at 8.30am – 12.30pm.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Conduct routine tasks such as leaf raking, weeding, dead heading, floor bumping, manual pest control to increase a high standard of display.
- 2. To follow the direction, training and supervision of Botanical Horticulturist and other staff in the maintenance and creation of displays in the Glasshouses, from propagation to planting and pruning.

- 3. To ensure all BBG assets such as tools & plants are well looked after and maintained, that all BBG facilities are respected and kept tidy e.g. break areas, toilets.
- 4. To work independently and part as a team, towards the area management plan and in line with Living Collections Strategy, Health and Safety policy.

SUPERVISION

Working under the direction and/or supervision of Botanical Horticulturists and other more senior staff.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Manual handling, hot, humid, cold, small spaces, public areas and back of house areas.
